

To Find your District's Charter School Rate

This example is for LVCS and the Dallas School District for the 11/16/08 Charter School Rate. We will use the data from the State School Fund Sheet located on the ODE web site (www.ode.state.or.us)

$$1. \quad \frac{\text{2008-09 Gen. Purpose Grant (Bottom Left)}}{\text{Estimated ADMw (Top Left)}} = \frac{\$22,690,368}{\$3,723.60} = \$ 6093.66 \quad (\$6,094)$$

- ❖ The Estimated ADMw is reflected in both the numerator and the denominator.
- ❖ The Estimated ADMw contains the poverty factor in the original weighting from the State School Fund Grant. So, it is true that the poverty factor was at one time included in the ADMw. However, because they cancel each other out, the poverty factor is eliminated and must be added back in.
- ❖ ORS 338.157 addresses this need.
